Board Meeting

Jack, Jo Cooley, Beverly Harmon, and Michelle Kemps present. (Beverly's home)

It occurred to us that Linda was missing at the last Board meeting (January 23 - Michelle's Home) and therefore there were No Minutes. This document will cover all topics discussed at both meetings.

1. Membership Dues

FFI takes \$15 / member.....we are paying \$35 member......leaves us \$20 /member FFI just increased to \$20 / member.....we need to charge \$40 / memberleaves us \$20 / member

- 2) FFI has increased their Outbound Fee to \$170 / week to pay their staff.
- 3) We have been charging \$150 for Inbound Journeys. It is too difficult to keep within that budget. Michelle did a survey of nearby clubs. Everyone is charging more. We, the board, propose raising the Inbound fee to \$175.
- 4) We feel the duties of the membership person needs to take care of the Directory as of next year.
- 5) We feel the JC, AC and Membership person is responsible for collecting necessary money. When appropriate total and give to treasurer.

- 6) The duties of the Treasurer are to store the monthly statements from the bank and write all necessary checks. This transaction will take place by the next board election.
- 7) Recites for purchase are Necessary for a refund.
- 8) Nominating Committee schedule. Spring and Summer they are to fill all positions. Sept meeting start announcing those that have accepted. October is LAST month do fill all necessary positions. November they are announced. November there will be a Mentor meeting with all new positions being mentored by an experienced member. December meeting they all will be inducted. We want to add a slot for a volunteer for the Ice Cream Social. Will check on progress at the end of April. If they need help we will try to find someone who has done it before to coach them.
- 9) Beverly and Ginny will compile a list of names, addresses, phone numbers, and contact person if applicable of 1) all locations we've used meetings and 2) places for Lunch Please feel free to write a comment as 'Yes place worked out', 'No people did not like etc etc' This will be passed to the new Vice Presidents.
- 10) There was much discussion about the Australia Inbound Journey. We all read the surveys. We all agreed it was a total success and Participation was nearly 100%. There were two issues we need to address. 1) We need to remind members that Politics and Religion should really not be a topic to discuss. 2) When we see a person with dietary need is coming we need to contact them and have they be specific as to their needs. It is our responsibility to ask, it is their responsibility to give us detailed information.

We were extremely pleased with the many small dinners. Doing this there is no need to pay the host \$50....which without fundraisers is hard to justify.

- 11) Discussed June Lunch....but got it mixed up with the Ice Cream Social. All has been squared away.
- 12) Online banking was discussed. We feel it is the way of the future. The Sun Trust bank has given us their rates. We need to compare them with other banks. We need a Webmaster to work with us. Richard is leaving the position after 6 years. We have agreed to try and research during the hot quiet months of the summer. If we decide to do it, we would implement it in the fall and have it up and running for the upcoming year's membership dues in November. This way we can make sure it is ready for the next board. Sarasota is working with Fifth Third Bank, so we will ask them for some advice.

Michelle has contacted Allison Lindsey from FFI and asked to have information on Online Banking.

13) We talked about Fundraisers. We all agree we don't like them. However it may come down to we NEED someday to replenish our yearly costs.....Web page, Newsletter, Membership to FFI, misc things like Ice Cream Social. Michelle did a survey of nearby clubs. Many have simple Fundraisers like, having a Wine tasting, Cocktail Hour, then all go to restaurant, Lunch at home after meeting, going to movies etc. For each of these events they charge \$5 from each participating member. It might be possible to tack it onto the Out and About program? Another means of getting money into the primary account is making the Journey deposit non refundable. Could be 100% non refundable or 50% non refundable. When people sign up to do something (attend the Farewell dinner) and decide NOT to go.....they can send someone in their place or forfeit the money, No Refunds.

Another club has a system whereby if you can not participate in an incoming journey, you may have to option to donate \$25 towards a luncheon for the ambassadors. A thank you card is drawn up to let the ambassadors know who is paying. The AC usually will take them someplace where the meal is just under that amount and the excess money goes into the Primary Account.

14) An oversight !!! As I was scooping up the board meeting paperwork and I saw Jack's financial paper. Jack spent much time reviewing the Online Banking. It is with his compilation that we confirmed we need to interview other banks come summer time.
