2017: Anticipating Canada and Japan Exchanges



We look forward to 2017 Oubound Exchange to Canada - Stratford-St Mary and Haliburton Highlands, Ontario. According to their website, Stratford-St Mary says "Few places in Ontario are lovelier or more alive with culture and character than Stratford. It is a charming city nestled in pastoral countryside in Southwestern Ontario.

Stratford Shakespeare Festival is North America's largest classical repertory theatre, presenting the works of William Shakespeare and other great writers in its idyllic setting on the Avon River. Nine miles southwest is St. Marys, a charming small town, with many limestone buildings and houses, situated on the Thames River and Trout Creek. Its limestone deposits led to the development of a very well known Canadian cement company, St. Marys Cement. It boasts Canada's largest outdoor swimming pool, the Quarry."

The second club, Haliburton Highlands is a larger club (~ 75 members). They say "Our June/September exchanges begin with a welcome party and usually include the following elements: boat trip on one of our lakes, tour of the local artisan studios, trip to the Wolf Centre and the Fish Hatchery, and a walk along one of our trails through the woods." We received word that this is a **"cooperative exchange"** with the **Tbilisi Club** in the country of **Georgia**. Current suggested date is June 2017. Lou Rizk, Kev Janiak and Susan Beaudry volunteered to be EDs for this awesome outbound trip.

But there is more news! Regarding our international incoming exchange, the club of Hiroshima, Japan has been approved to visit us in March 2017. Members of our club visited them about 3 years ago. It will be great to return their wonderful hospitality.
