## Mobile Passport - An App worth downloading!

Richard and I recently tried a new phone app called **Mobile Passport** which helped us skip the long lines at U.S. Customs when we re-entered our country from visiting Africa. It's GREAT!! You've got to try it.

Here's the 4 quick steps:


- 1. **Download the APP** to your phone and open it
- 2. *Type in details* from your passport or scan it with your phone's camera. Then take a selfie. No hats or funny face, please! Guess What? You can add your family to the app. You can do it from home, at the airport or *even on board* the plane. Your personal info is stored on your phone for future use.
- 3. **Answer 4 questions.** On the long flight home, just pull out your phone (yes, even in airplane mode), open the app, tap **New Trip**, select the airport you are coming into, and answer their 4 basic

questions. You won't need the US Customs paper form that the

stewardess is distributing!

4. **Get the receipt.** When you've landed just turn on the phone's WiFi connection, open the app and press a button. The app submits all the info to Customs and gives you a digital receipt with a QR code. **This is your ticket to the EXPRESS LANE!** 

When you get to the boarder control area, find the dedicated Mobile Passport Lane. It is **much**, **much shorter** than the regular lane. If you don't see it, just ask! It's so short that it may be hidden! When your turn comes, hand over your passport to the customs officer and wave your app on your phone over a scanner. Answer a few questions and you're on your way to get your luggage. You'll scan the app one more time after you grab your bags.

# 2017: Outbound to Canada and Japan Inbound Exchanges




