# Upcoming Inbound Michigan Journey February 1 - 8, 2018

The committee has been hard at work and here is the tentative schedule for the Michigan ambassadors:

#### Thursday, Feb. 1

Ambassadors will arrive at Fort Myers Airport at 2:40 p.m. They will be greeted by their host



families. Some of the ambassadors will arrive by car and meet at the host families home.

The rest of the evening is to relax and get to know each other and perhaps the neighborhood.

#### Friday, Feb. 2

Hosts and Ambassadors will meet at the Fort Myers down town library for the clubs monthly meeting. The program will be a cross cultural class. After the meeting and program, the group will drive to ECHO, an experimental farm that provides resources to third world agricultural development for single family farmers. We will have lunch there and a tour of the farm and the "technology" area. After the tour, we will visit Manatee Park and hopefully see some manatees in the river. Evening is free with hosts.

#### Saturday, Feb. 3

Arrive at 10:45 at the Peace River Wild Life Refuge in Punta Gorda for a tour. Adjourn to the home of Sue and Rob Linehan for a lunch, followed by a sail in the harbor on the catamaran, Catalyst. Evening is free.

#### Sunday, Feb. 4

Have a relaxed morning, enjoy a brunch, go to church if that is something you would like to do. Visit

Koreshan State Historic Site in Estero at 1:30. Enjoy the farmers market and then we will have a tour of the site at 2:00. We will adjourn to our small dinner parties that evening.

#### Monday, Feb. 5

This is a free day with your hosts. Discuss what activities might be in their area and what your interests might be. This is a good day to treat the hosts, either to lunch or dinner. Discuss this with your hosts so that they can make appropriate advance plans.

#### Tuesday, Feb. 6

Drive to Pine Island where we will meet for a tour of the Calusa Indian Mounds and have a guided tour. We will then have lunch and do some shopping at some of the funky old Florida shops in Matlasha. Evening is free.

#### Wednesday, Feb. 7

Drive to Punta Gorda's new Botanical Sculpture Garden for a presentation and tour. After lunch we will visit a rum distillery, Vietnam Wall replica, Hurricane Charlie Memorial and see a very large banyan tree before heading to the farewell party.

#### Thursday, Feb. 8
