Member's Recipes

Jo's Carmel Popcorn

2 qt. Pan (no smaller) ½ lb. Butter (no substitutes) 1 C. Brown sugar ½ C. Corn Syrup Mix the above together and heat to a boil for 2 min.

Add 1 teaspoon soda and stir well (careful - this will boil up very quickly and is very hot!)

8 oz. hulless popcorn (puffs)

Pour over popcorn and mix well until each kernel is evenly covered.

Bake at 350 degrees for 45 min. stirring about every 10 min. Jo says, " Hope everyone enjoys a good snack!
