They have 21 people on their list and the number coming depends upon whether they can obtain their visa(s). Most of them are adults ranging in age from 30's to early 50's with one senior (age 67). They also asked to bring some teens and possibly 2 children, ages 7 and 9.

We will be calling you soon to request housing for our Russian ambassadors - so please be prepared to say yes!
