**Every year Friendship Force International (FFI)** in Atlanta lets us know who matched to visit our club. Next year, in 2020, we will welcome a group from Saratov!

It is a large city (region's population is 2.5 million) situated in the southeast, the European part of Russia, on the right bank of the Volga River and located about 520 miles southeast of Moscow. It is an important cultural, economic and educational center of the Volga region.

The city is known as a center of higher education, research and scientific activities. Beside one of the oldest universities in Russia, there are over a dozen colleges in the city. Saratov is an important industrial center of the Volga River area. Its industries are machine-building, oil and chemical. Saratov


Club President, *Michelle Kemps*, is taking an Educational Opportunities riverboat cruise to Budapest, Hungary and Prague, Czech Republic.
