FF Gold Coast from Sept 4 to 11th

FF Blue Mountains from **Sept 11 to 18th** 



On the 4th we will make our own arrangements to fly into Brisbane. We will then take the train to FF Gold Coast. We do not have a meet time or place in Brisbane so *don't buy tickets* just yet.

On September 11th we will fly out of the Gold Coast Airport to Sydney. From there we take the train to Blue Mountains. I will be arranging the flights and all train tickets with a local agent. The cost will be part of the fee.
