The Journey Coordinator is Joanne Collins assisted by Susan Hills. Our host coordinator is Jane Parker, wife of club president, Andrew. We've established a firm date of **May 18-24, 2026**. We filled the 14 slots. and some of us will go on a pre-trip rail journey to Wales and some on a post-trip tour by a Canadian company, *Wing Buddy*, to Scotland in an 18-passenger mini van.



All chapter members are welcome to join the book club discussion of this most interesting story of a man who leaves Stockholm in 1916 for an Arctic adventure, survives an avalanche, and retreats to a solitary life until an unexpected visitor transforms his isolated existence. The book was long-listed for the Center for Fiction First Novel Prize and was described in the New York Time Book Review as "*Briskly entertaining*" and in People Magazine as "*transporting and wholly original.*"


